

## FIRTH OF CLYDE - DEPLOYMENT OF HYDROPHONE RECEIVERS

Mariners are advised that Hydrophone Receivers have been deployed at various locations in the Firth of Clyde as illustrated on the following chart extract. These will remain in place until around the end of August 2021.



The receivers have been moored on the seabed (image on left) or attached to channel markers (image on right). They are in place to track salmon smolts and will only detect the specific tag signals. Both types of receiver are shown below. 
