

NOTICE TO MARINERS

HEYSHAM HARBOUR

YELLOW ST ANDREW'S CROSS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that further to Notice to Mariners №6/2021 “Unidentified Mark” and subsequent consultation with Harbour users, it has been established that the yellow St Andrew’s cross in question is used by some mariners as a steering mark.

Whilst the former engineering workshops and LMS building at the west-end of the South Quay have been demolished, the yellow St Andrews cross has been retained and relocated to position 54° 01' 55.4" N 002° 55' 12.8" W (approx.).

This steering mark will not be recognised as a formal aid to navigation; however, its presence will be considered as part of the forthcoming general review of Heysham Harbour aids to navigation.
