IRON MEN MAINTENANCE PROJECT CROSBY BEACH

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 17 May 2021, or soon thereafter, work will commence re-piling the Iron Men statues on Crosby Beach.

The work (performed using land-based vehicles, e.g. quad bikes, 4 x 4 vehicles and excavators) will take place above the mean low water level at Crosby Beach within the area marked “Numerous Statues” as shown on UKHO chart №1951 (Approaches to Liverpool). Small vessels navigating outside the buoyed channel in this area should proceed with due care and caution.
