

Great Yarmouth Port Waste Management Plan October 2019

Addendum 1

It is noted and agreed the following changes with immediate effect are incorporated in the Port Waste Management Plan:

Page 6 **International Catering Waste**, Para commencing **Domestic Waste** is deleted and replaced by:

Domestic waste that has either originated from outside the UK, Channel Islands and Isle of Man or is on a vessel which has in the last two years travelled outside the UK, Channel Islands and Isle of Man will be treated as ICW. This is a Category 1 Waste and must be separately declared. GYPC will assist the Master/ship Agent if required to ensure provision of a special container.

Page 8 **Waste Collection Facilities Available**, The Table is amended on line 3 to read:

Type of Waste	Collection Facility	Location	Special arrangements
Domestic Category 1 (Non-UK origin)	Clinical waste bags and dedicated skip.	As required	Cat 1 skip will be delivered to the ship as required. Collection will be arranged as required.

All other Terms, conditions and provisions of the Plan remain unchanged

The designation of *International Catering Waste (ICW)* is amended by UK Government [Handling and disposing of international catering waste](#)

Waste is now considered ICW if a vessel travels outside the UK, Channel Islands and Isle of Man, even if stocked up for the entire journey in the UK, Channel Islands and Isle of Man.
